
# 35th Annual Bois d'Arc Bash September 24 & 25, 2021

### Rules & Regulations (please read all of these & keep this page for your records)

- 1. Vendor application is for SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2021 ONLY.
- 2. Booth priority is given to current Chamber members in good standing and returning vendors in good standing.
- 3. All vendors must submit a signed and dated application form—along with full payment—to the Chamber office by September 3, 2021. Get your form and payment in early!
- 4. Vendor applications are subject to approval and acceptance by the Vendor Committee and our decision is final.
- 5. ALL applications are considered ACCEPTED unless the Vendor Committee informs you otherwise.
- 6. Vendors will be notified of their space number a few days before the Bash. Please be sure and include an E-MAIL ADDRESS as this is the preferred and fastest method of communication.
- 7. Vendor setup begins at 6 a.m. on Saturday and ALL VEHICLES must be off the square by 8:30 a.m. due to the parade.
- 8. All vendors MUST enter the square at the south entrance on Washington Street (by Chase Bank). Someone will direct you to your booth location. If you arrive earlier than 6 a.m., BE PREPARED TO WAIT UNTIL WE ARRIVE. Please don't question the people setting up the pancake breakfast—they have no information and cannot let you in.
- 9. Absolutely no tear-down of booths allowed until at least 6 p.m. Vehicles will be allowed on the square for loading **AFTER 6 p.m**. No exceptions! (If you want to carry out your items by hand before 6 p.m., you may do so)
- 10. Vendors may stay later than 6 p.m. with Vendor Committee approval. (Let us know when you send your application.)
- 11. Vendors are responsible for providing their own tents, tables, chairs, extension cords, etc. Please leave an entrance/exit at the front of your space.
- 12. All booth materials must fit within your rented space. Tents need to be straight-legged tents so they fit inside your space.
- 13. Placement of booths will be at the discretion of the Vendor Committee.
- 14. All vendors are responsible for the security of their goods. The Chamber of Commerce and Bash Committee accept no responsibility for stolen or damaged property, accidents or injury.
- 15. \*\*\*Each vendor is expected to clean up their space at the end of the day. We will provide a trash bag at check-in for you to use throughout the day—please don't fill up the trash cans with boxes, etc.
- 16. **PROHIBITED ITEMS**: stink bombs, poppers or similar items. No knives or toy weapons may be sold—this includes potato guns and sling shots—*unless otherwise approved by the Vendor Committee*. No drug paraphernalia or drug emblems, or items with inappropriate language or nudity, will be allowed for sale or giveaway. No real/imitation/substitute tobacco products will be allowed for sale or giveaway. NO political items to be sold (candidates/parties may give away).
- 17. \*\*\*Vendors may not give away items being sold elsewhere at the Bash by other vendors (such as bottled water, drinks, food, etc.)\*\*\*
- 18. Due to the amount of advertising the Chamber does in preparation for the Bash, it is a RAIN or SHINE event. No refunds.
- 19. If you have an emergency or require assistance during festival hours, please go to the Chamber booth located at Alamo and Washington (near the stage).
- 20. The Vendor Committee reserves the right to revoke or refuse to grant booth space at any time, without recourse by the participant. The Vendor Committee also reserves the right to change/move a vendor if circumstances make it necessary.
- 21. Signature on the application is required and states that vendor is aware of all rules and regulations and agrees to abide by them.
- 22. The Bois d'Arc Bash may be cancelled after commencement due to acts of God or other actions that may endanger any participants or vendors. In the event that the Bash is cancelled, absolutely no refunds will be issued.
- 23. \*\*The State of Texas required vendors to provide the Chamber with a valid Tax ID number or a verified exception.
- 24. \*\*If you are doing a bake sale, or selling ANY type of food items, you MUST contact Debra at Hunt County Health Dept.
